


# MyiLibrary for Kindle Fire

- 1) Create a MyiLibrary account if you have not already done so. [Follow these instructions on how to do this.](#)
- 2) Install the Bluefire Reader app (or another compatible eReader app) on your device, and authorize your device with your Adobe ID. You will need to follow these [special instructions to download the Bluefire Reader app on your Kindle Fire.](#) If you do not have an Adobe ID, [follow these instructions on how to do this.](#)
- 3) On your Kindle Fire, use your browser to access MyiLibrary. You can access this collection through your library's website, or via [nclive.org](http://nclive.org).
- 4) Find an eBook by searching or browsing the collection. Click on a title to see more details.
- 5) If the book is downloadable, you will see a **"Add to Bookshelf to Download"** link.




- 6) If you are not already signed into your MyiLibrary account, you will be prompted to do so now.

7) Click on "**My Account**" and then on "**Bookshelf**" to see the eBook you have added.



8) To download a title from your Bookshelf, scroll over to the far right of the page until you see the Download button. You will see a popup menu saying, "You must first download to device before reading," so just tell it "Ok" for it to begin the download.



9) Go to your browser's download page by tapping on your Kindle browser menu in the top left corner.

10) Select the top download title. Tell it to open in Bluefire Reader then select "**Go to library**" when prompted. You will see your title in your Bluefire Reader bookshelf.
