



## eBooks on EBSCOhost for Kindle Fire


- 1) Create an EBSCOhost account if you have not already done so. [Follow these instructions on how to do this.](#)
- 2) Install the Bluefire Reader app (or another compatible eReader app) on your device, and authorize your device with your Adobe ID. You will need to follow these [special instructions to download the Bluefire Reader app on your Kindle Fire.](#) If you do not have an Adobe ID, [follow these instructions on how to do this.](#)
- 3) On your Kindle Fire, use your browser to access eBooks on EBSCOhost. You can access this collection through your library's website, or via [nclive.org](http://nclive.org).
- 4) If you are viewing the mobile version of the site, you will need to click the "**Full Site**" link near the bottom of the screen.




5) Once you locate the book you want, click the “**Download (Offline)**” link to begin the downloading process.



6) To download the eBook to your device, click the “**Checkout & Download**” button.



7) You will then be prompted to open the eBook with Bluefire Reader.



8) Once Bluefire has processed the eBook, you will have the option to "**Go To Library**" or "**Read Now.**"
