### **Process and Timeline**

In order to ensure the best possible suite of resources for our communities, we selected resources based on community input and expert assessment. We solicited recommendations in a survey open to every library staff person at every member institution across the state. Every recommendation was considered and assessed by the Resource Advisory Committee (RAC), which consists of three representatives from each of NC LIVE's four Communities of Interest (COIs). Recommendations from the RAC were then reviewed and approved by the Librarians' Council (LC), which is comprised of COI representatives, committee chairs, and the State Librarian of NC. We are excited to report that we were able to add every resource recommended by four or more library staff members across the state.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **General FAQs**

#### MY LIBRARY HAS ITS OWN SUBSCRIPTION TO ONE OF THE NEWLY-ADDED RESOURCES. CAN I GET A REFUND NOW THAT NC LIVE IS PROVIDING IT TO THE WHOLE CONSORTIUM?

We have negotiated with vendors to ensure that any existing subscriptions that member libraries hold to new NC LIVE resources will be prorated and refunded appropriately. You can contact your vendor directly to initiate this process.

#### **CAN LIBRARIES GET EARLY ACCESS TO A RESOURCE BEFORE IT LAUNCHES ON JANUARY 1?**

NC LIVE libraries already have complimentary, early access to Historic North Carolina Digital Newspaper Collection, ProQuest Research Companion, eLibrary Curriculum Edition, and SIRS Discoverer from Proquest. Some additional resources may be available prior to January 1. If early access becomes available, we will notify member libraries.

### SOME OF THESE RESOURCES ARE NEW TO ME. WHAT OPPORTUNITIES ARE AVAILABLE FOR TRAINING ON THE NEW RESOURCES?

#### **HOW LONG ARE THE CONTRACTS FOR?**

Six years for all ProQuest resources (see list on page 9), and three years for all other resources.

### I USE EZPROXY TO ENABLE OFFSITE ACCESS TO NC LIVE RESOURCES. HOW/WHEN/WHO WILL CONFIGURE MY EZPROXY TO ENABLE THESE NEW RESOURCES? Will I get MARC records for the new resources?

As we get closer to launching the new resources, we'll be sending out an email for each new resource with proxy information and MARC records.

### I UNDERSTAND THERE ARE OPTIONS FOR THE CREDO REFERENCE COLLECTION. WHAT ARE THEY, AND WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

The choices for the Credo Reference collection are <u>Academic Core</u> or <u>Complete Core</u>. Academic Core is comprised of around 700 titles with a focus on academic general reference for college and university settings. Complete Core is comprised of around 1,000 titles and includes all the content of Academic Core as well as content geared toward general-interest patrons and younger audiences in a public library setting, e.g., juvenile reference, test prep, parenting titles, DIY books, etc. Public libraries will default to Complete Core; academic libraries will default to Academic Core; and existing customers will default to their current selection. Any library can switch to another version upon request NC LIVE and Credo will be in touch with each member library to implement your Reference Core choice.

#### WILL THERE BE ANY CHANGES IN NC LIVE'S PERPETUAL ACCESS COLLECTIONS?

NC LIVE will continue to provide perpetual access to the following collections of own materials:

### Summon FAQs

#### WILL MY LIBRARY HAVE TO PAY FOR SUMMON?

No. NC LIVE has negotiated Summon into our agreement with ProQuest. Summon is available to your library at no charge.

#### WHEN CAN I IMPLEMENT SUMMON?

If you are interested, you can begin implementation of your instance of Summon as early as November 2017.

#### **HOW DO I IMPLEMENT SUMMON?**

You can sign up for a preferred implementation spot.

#### WHAT DOES THE NC LIVE SUMMON DEAL INCLUDE?

Summon, 360Link and E-Journal Portal.

#### WHAT IF I ALREADY HAVE SUMMON?

Contact your ProQuest representative with any questions. You will no longer have to pay for Summon beginning January 1, 2018, but it is prudent to contact your rep to discuss any details about your current contract.

#### WHAT IF I ALREADY HAVE ANOTHER DISCOVERY SERVICE LIKE EDS OR WORLDSHARE?

You can continue those, or adopt Summon. The choice is up to you.

#### **DO I HAVE TO IMPLEMENT SUMMON?**

Although Summon is available to all 205 NC LIVE member libraries, whether you choose to adopt it is entirely up to you. Some libraries may not see the value in a discovery service. Other libraries may already have a discovery service that they prefer. Implementing Summon is entirely optional.

#### WHO CURRENTLY USES SUMMON IN NORTH CAROLINA?

North Carolina libraries like <u>NCSU</u>, <u>Wake Forest</u>, and <u>Surry Community College</u>, to name a few, currently use Summon. Also, NC LIVE has used Summon since 2015. The prominent search boxes on all of these webpages are entry points to Summon.
