- 4) What were Dean Smith's and Charlie Scott's individual and collective achievements during their time together at UNC Chapel Hill? After? What do you think was the most significant achievement and why?
- 5) In what ways were UNC Chapel Hill, the town of Chapel Hill, and collegiate athletics transformed by Dean Smith and Charlie Scott?
