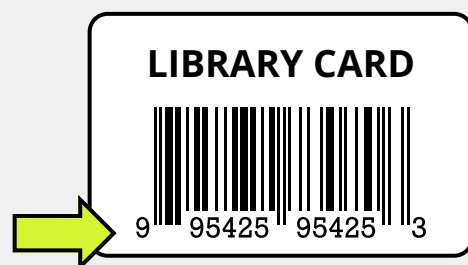


Technology Skills for Everyday Life

Did you know that your local library has tools to help you learn more about using technology, the internet, and AI? These tools are free to access with a library card. If you need help, you can always ask a librarian.

HOW TO LOG IN

- Go to **nclive.org/welcome**
- If you have a library card, select your library from the drop-down list. It may be the name of your library system. Then, enter your library card number and PIN (if it asks for one).
- If you don't have a library card yet, you can sign up for a free 10-day pass.



- Your library card number is usually near the barcode.
- If you don't know your PIN, ask a librarian.

LEARN COMPUTER SKILLS

- Once you're logged in, go to **nclive.org/browse** or click "Resources" at the top of the page to "Browse all resources."
- Select "LearningExpress Library."
- You can create an account with your own email to save your progress under "Register."
- Select "Basic Computer Skills" to see videos and tutorials on using computers, the internet, Microsoft products, and more!
