## How to log in

### Option 1: Library Login

2. Log in with your library card number

### Option 2: NC LIVE Login

1. Go to: [resources.nclive.org/dataaxle](http://resources.nclive.org/dataaxle)
2. Select your library
3. Enter your library card number

# Getting started with data axle

## Step 1: Login

Go to [resources.nclive.org/dataaxle](http://resources.nclive.org/dataaxle) and log in with your library card.

- If you'd like to make an account to save your progress, click "Register Now" on the homepage.

## Step 2: Select a database to begin

"U.S. Businesses" is a great place to start.

## Example: Find clients & partners

Imagine you have a concrete pouring business. You can search for general contractors who might hire you:


- Go to "U.S. Businesses" database
- Click the "Advanced Search" tab
- Under the "Business Type" heading in the left side menu, click the "Keyword/SIC/NAICS" box
- Select "Search Primary SIC Only" and enter keywords to find the corresponding industry codes. Ex. "General contractor"
- Then, select "County" in the "Geography" menu (left)
- Select your state and county
- Click "Update Count" in the top right corner to see your list!

# For Entrepreneurs

If you're starting your own business, Data-Axle can help you get started with market and competitor information.

## U.S. Businesses Database

- Use keywords to find corresponding industry codes or ask a librarian for help with finding how many businesses exist in your industry in your area
- Look at existing businesses' number of employees, location, sales volume, and more data
- Download lists of business owners and contacts to create mailing lists and start marketing campaigns

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## U.S. Consumers/Lifestyle Database

- Check the "Lifestyles" box to find the your target market by interest. Ex. For a dog grooming business, you can search for households with dogs and cross-filter for income.
- Create a heat map of consumers to find out where to locate your business.

## Example: Grow your business

Imagine you are a wedding planner looking to build your vendor contacts. When you search your metro area for caterers, you get 800+ results!

- Narrow your list down by selecting "Map Based Search" under "Geography" on the left side menu
- Draw a shape on the map around the area you want to focus on and double click to get a new count.
